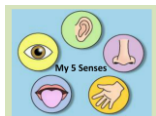

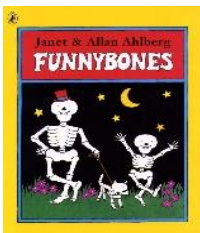
HOOK: Sharing favourite spooky stories. Role-play haunted house with skeleton costumes.
