MENTAL HEALTH AND WELL BEING: 5 Ways to Wellbeing Number 4~ Help your child to foster a love of learning

It is important that children don't just associate 'learning' with school. At Landscope we hope that we instil a love of learning in the children that means they become 'life long learners'. As parents and carers you have an important role to play too! Passing on skills like cooking, sewing, gardening and photography show your child that learning can be fun and they provide opportunities to 'connect' (one of our earlier 5 ways to wellbeing).

Reading with your child and encouraging them to read 'just for fun' is so important. There is research that suggests children who read for pleasure have increased attainment, it is actually a more influential factor than their family's socio~ economic status!
