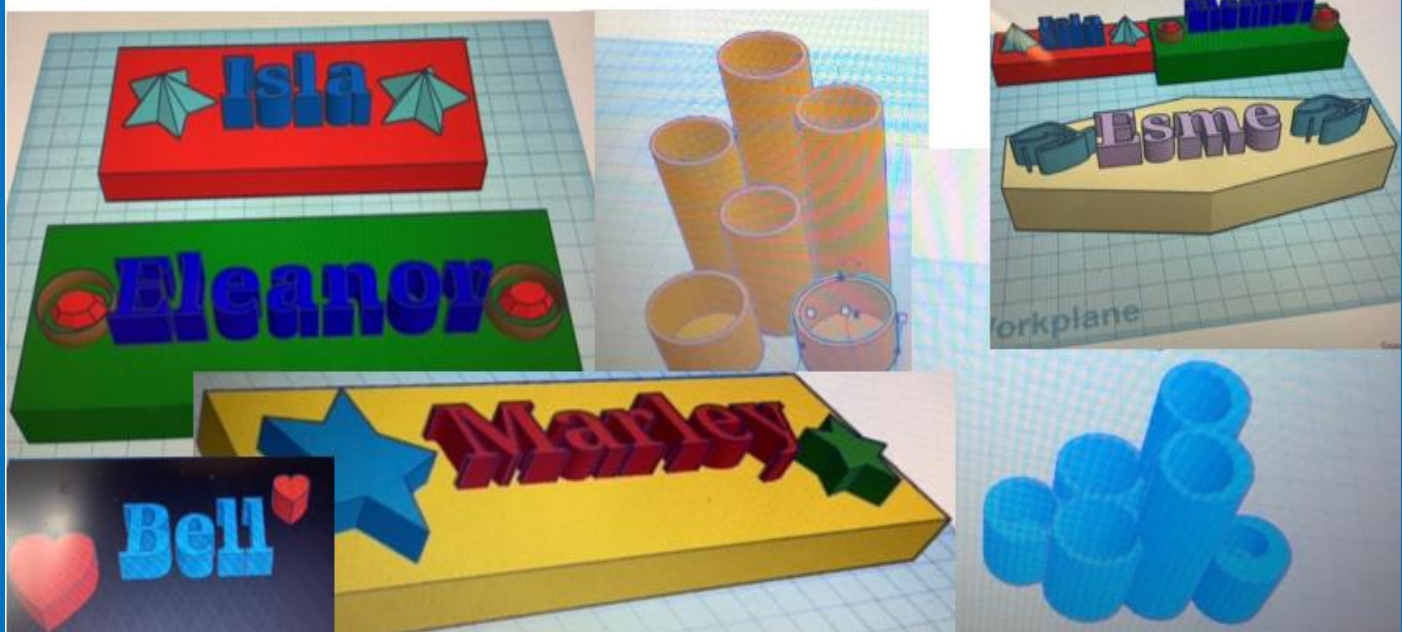
Class 2 enjoyed an afternoon in the sunshine on Friday hunting for wild and common garden plants and trees. They worked in partners to find them using an identification sheet.

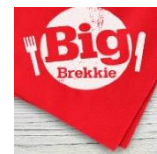
Class 4 are loving their Computing Unit on 3D modelling. They have created name badges and desk tidies using the Tinkercad web app.
