## UPDATED COVID-19 ACTIONS FOR PARENTS DURING THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY

If your child starts to display COVID symptoms before 2.00 p.m. on Sunday, 20th December and as a result tests positive for COVID, you must inform school by telephoning our emergency phone **07908 012864** as class 'bubbles' will continue to be affected due to contact tracing. The telephone will be on, between the hours of 10-12 each morning until the 24th Dec.

If your child starts to display COVID symptoms after 2.00 p.m. on Sunday 20th December and as a result tests positive for COVID you do not have to inform school but refer to Track and Trace for advice.(class 'bubbles' will not be affected).

Positive test results of children prior to school return: - Please inform school if your child tests positive for COVID during the Christmas break and their isolation period affects their return to school on Tuesday 5th January 2021.
