LANDSCOVE LEARNERS

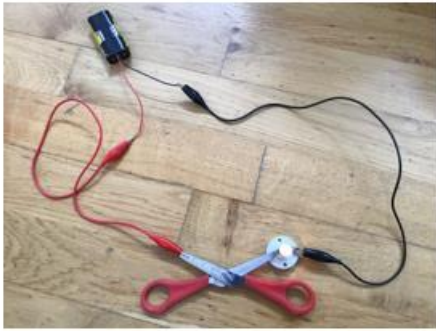
