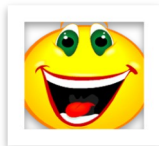


Personal, Social and Emotional Development

⇒ Exercise, healthy diet, hygiene and rest.

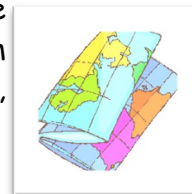
Mathematics

- Developing IT skills - Beebots, iPads & laptops.

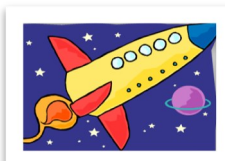
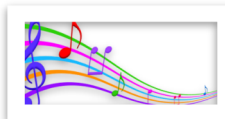


Spring Term 2022 Topics for Reception

Expressive Arts and Design

- On-going music skills linked with our topic work, to include lots of songs, singing games and rhymes, using voices and percussion.
- Collage work, printing and painting inspired by planets and aliens and dinosaurs!

- Set up a class spaceship and dinosaur museum for role play.

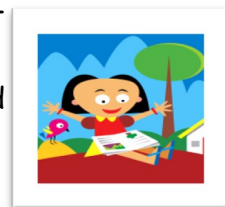


Active Learning: Being Involved & Concentrating
Maintaining focus on an activity for a period of time and persisting with an activity.

Communication and Language And Literacy

Listening to and enjoying a variety of topic related stories, along with a range of other fiction, non-fiction texts, poetry and songs.

- Lots of role play from stories and in our class spaceship and museum!
- Development of letters and sounds work to include blending for reading and simple sounding out words in their writing.
- Application of our phonics skills for writing during guided and independent activities, and child-initiated play activities.
- Continuing work on correct letter formation.
- Book sharing, story CD's and guided reading sessions.
- Show and Tell sessions
- Activities to develop our Oracy skills.



Physical Development

During this term the children will be continuing with our sessions with Mr Tanner, focusing on throwing and catching skills through object control and hand eye co-ordination activities.
