Class three's beach clean at Elberry Cove.

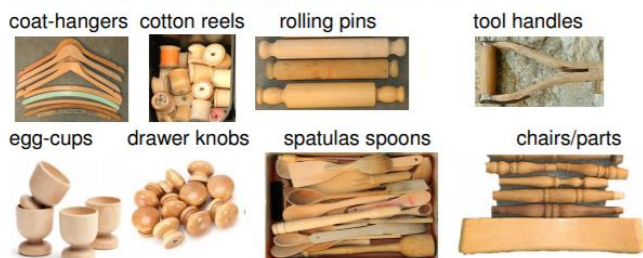

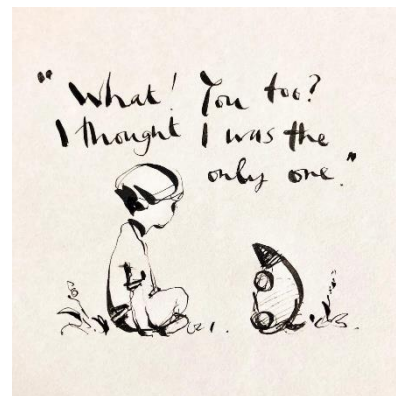
ETHOS & VALUES
