A 5 star education:

During their time in our school, children will be offered the opportunity to:

Enrichment

In addition to a normal range of sports, children will be able to take part in fencing, archery, cross-country events, learning a martial art, as well as having the opportunity to work alongside GCSE & A level students to choreograph their own dance and perform in a dance theatre.

Music

Wider opportunities: children will have regular opportunities to have taster days/ and blocked lessons (usually ½ a terms worth) learning to play a range of instruments including recorders, clarinets, djembes, p bones, pocket trumpets and ukuleles. These lessons will be supported by music specialists as part of the wider opportunities available to Devon schools.
