Hook: Sharing our favourite skeleton stories, role play set up as haunted house!


Elicitation task – Create a class KWL grid – what do we already know and what do we want to know...

Final event: Sharing our skeleton stories with younger children!


Review our class KWL grid – What did we know, what did we want to know and what did we find out?
