As in previous terms, we will set weekly homework on Spelling Shed on Wednesdays which is due to be completed by the following Monday. TTR should be accessed 4-5 times per week, either in the 'garage' or 'studio'. Regular practice makes a huge difference to children's ability to spell accurately and rapidly recite tables.

A visit to Riverford Farm isn't far off along with a whole school PE activity day which will provide children with opportunities to get involved in a variety of different sports.
